Cheney Elementary School is getting prepared for another outstanding year with your student(s)! Our school system is once again armed with strong parental support and highly qualified personnel; the two essential pieces in putting together a great school system! This is a wonderful place to raise your family and CES is committed to providing the best educational opportunity available to you.

I'd like to welcome two new teachers to our family. Lori Rosenhagen will teach 2nd grade for us this year. Lori comes to us from Conway Spring and has taught in the Maize district as well. Her husband Greg will be the Cheney High School Assistant Principal and Athletic Director. The Rosenhagen family and their three girls will be moving to town this summer. Also new to our staff is Darrin San Romani. Darrin will teach in the 5th grade this year. He and his wife Emily grew up in Kingman and are anxious to be a part of our community. Please help us make both new teachers feel welcome as they move to our community.

A number of new families have contacted this past spring about moving to Cheney and we anticipate more coming in during enrollment. Help us welcome all of our new families and help make their adjustment to a new community as smooth as possible.

The Board of Education set the school fees for this year in an effort to offset some of the cuts required by the reduction of funding from the State of Kansas. You will see some increases in fees in some areas that are designed to help Cheney maintain the same quality of education we have seen in the past years.

- School fees were increased at each grade level
- The Kindergarten fees were increased to offset the cost of a full day program that is not funded by the State
- Lunch fees were increased minimally due to Federal guidelines and mandates.
- There has been a one-time fee added for activities and athletics at the middle school and high school level in an attempt to maintain our programs for students.

Enrollment fees are as follows:

Pre-School Tuition - \$125/month
Kindergarten Enrollment - \$100
1st – 5th Grades - \$70

Food Service Costs:

Lunches - \$1.95

Breakfast - \$1.15

Kindergarten and 1st Grade Snack Milk - \$31.50/semester

Extra Milk - \$0.35/carton

Some important dates to remember in August:

August 2nd and 4th – Enrollment at CES. The office will be open from 12:30 – 3:30, and 5:00 – 8:00 on both days

August 8 – Class Splits posted. You can look at the lists on the front door of the building.

August 23 – Open House at CES starting at 5:45 p.m. Come in and visit your student's classroom. You can also drop off school supplies that evening.

August 24 – First day of school!
